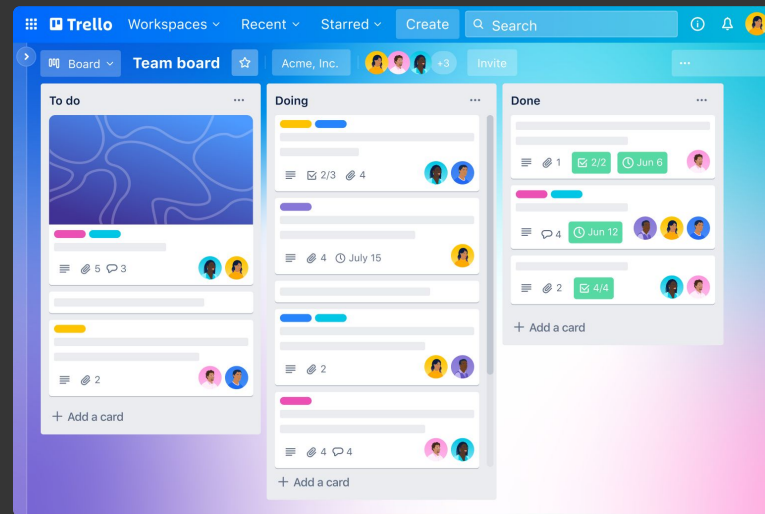


Trello - For Project Management

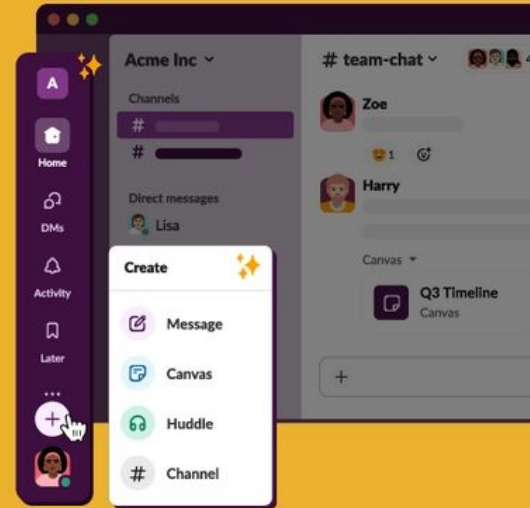

Slack - For Instant Messaging

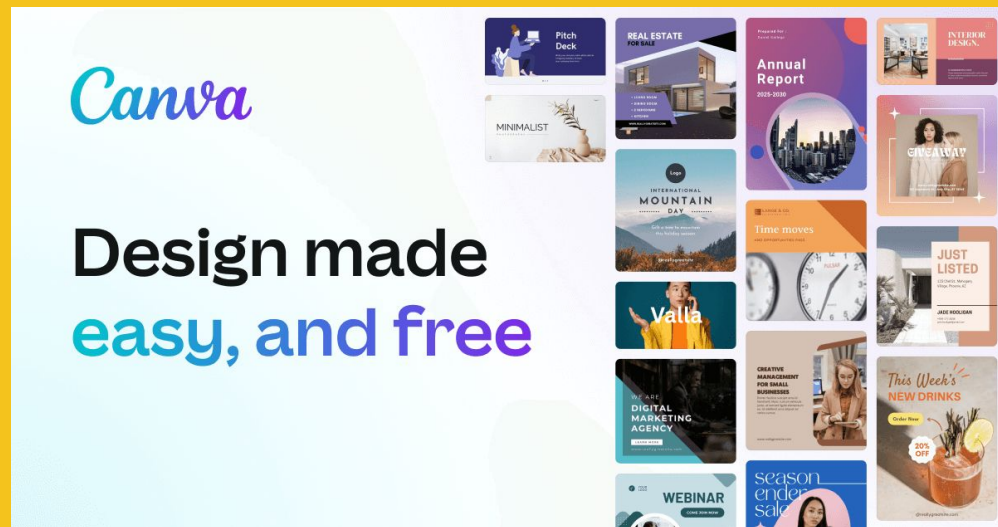
